



Acadia University and Techsploration Science Award

Techsploration gratefully acknowledges the generosity of Acadia University in providing a \$1000 scholarship to young women pursuing a Science Degree.

Who is eligible to apply?

- 1) All Techsplorer Alumnae are eligible to apply.
- 2) All female Grade 12 graduates of Techsploration schools in Nova Scotia are eligible to apply.
- 3) Applicants must be accepted into Acadia University's Faculty of Pure and Applied Science as a full-time student.

What are the criteria?

Scholarship applications will be evaluated on the basis of academic performance and a written essay. You must achieve a minimum 80% average upon high school graduation.

How do you apply?

Students must complete the attached application form and include a one-page essay and send it to the address on the application form.

What is the value?

The scholarship is valued at \$1000. The award will be applied directly to a student's tuition in two installments each year, the first in September and the second in January.

Applications must be received by the Scholarship Committee by **June 21, 2019**. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Only successful candidates will be notified.

- Describe any community, leadership, volunteer or employment activities in which you might be involved.

3. An Academic Reference

The applicant may ask a teacher to write a letter of recommendation on their behalf. The letter must be limited to one page and be signed by the teacher.
